- Converted and redesignated 10 October 1950 as Company A, 6th Infantry (12th Constabulary Squadron concurrently relieved from assignment to the 1st Constabulary Regiment)
- Activated 16 October 1950 in Germany
- Reorganized and redesignated 15 February 1957 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st Armored Rifle Battalion, 6th Infantry, and assigned to the 1st Armored Division (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated) Reorganized and redesignated 3 February 1962 as the 1st Battalion, 6th Infantry
- Relieved 12 May 1967 from assignment to the 1st Armored Division and assigned to the 198th Infantry Brigade
- Relieved 15 February 1969 from assignment to the 198th Infantry Brigade and assigned to the 23d Infantry Division
- Relieved 13 September 1972 from assignment to the 23d Infantry Division and assigned to the 1st Armored Division
